Additional requirements

- (a)Food must be pre-cooked.
- (b)Raw foods must be kept at a temperature no warmer than 41° Fahrenheit.
- (c)To the extent practicable, potentially hazardous foods must be cooked to order, and must be aggressively hot held at a temperature no less than 140° Fahrenheit.
- (d)A bleach water rinse must be maintained outside for the purpose of keeping wiping cloths, utensils and food contact surfaces clean and sanitary.
- (e)Sanitary utensils or foodservice gloves must be used for handling ready-to-eat foods.
- (f)Must have a chemical fire extinguisher rated at 2A-10BC. In addition, if charcoal or wood is used for cooking, vendor must have an approved water fire extinguisher of at least two and one-half gallons (Ord. No. 003-012, § 1, 4-22-03)



Food booths

- Tents must be fire rated for cooking if food will be prepared under the tent
- Food vendors will need to apply for temporary food permit (See attached Temporary Food Permit Application)
- Food booths will need to apply for a permit a minimum of 2 weeks in advance. Earlier is better. Menu MUST be included
- All food booths must have flooring (tarp or plywood) 3 tub wash sink, hand washing station, clear barrier on serving side of tent (See Temporary Food Event Basics 2020, Temporary Food Event 3 Comp sink, Temporary Handwash Station)
- Food preparation
 - All food should be quick cooking
 - Tents any cutting, chopping, dicing, should be done in advance in a commercial kitchen.
 - o FOOD PREPARED AT HOME IS NOT ALLOWED.
- Food booths will need the following infrastructure
 - Gray water tanks
 - Disposing of water on the ground or into a storm drain is not allowed
 - Grease barrels for any oil for fried foods
 - Access to water for the vendors to replenish from
 - o Disposing of water on the ground or into a storm drain is not allowed

Food trucks

- Food trucks will need to apply for a mobile food permit (See Mobile Food Unit Application)
- Mobile food units should apply and arrive for permitting inspections a minimum of 3 weeks in advance
